What is a Subscription Garden Program?

A Subscription Garden Program is a concept where participants subscribe to receive fresh-from-the-farm products from a local grower. This provides you and your family with fresh locally-grown produce that is much better for you, and helps to support the local economy in your community.

Will I be able to receive tomatoes in January?

No, tomatoes do not naturally grow in South Georgia during the month of January. But each week you will receive a basket full of seasonal vegetables and herbs plus pastured eggs and occasionally a canned product or other fresh from the farm goodie.

So what do you produce?



Asparagus, beets, carrots, dill, eggplant, flowers, garlic, hay, Italian green beans, jams & jellies, kale, lemon balm, mustard greens, nastrium, okra, peppers, q-cumbers, rosemary, strawberries, tomatoes, u-calyptus,

Vidalia-type onions, watermelons, x-tremeley good stuff, yellow squash, zucchini—plus a whole lot more!

Fresh Natural Produce

Our produce is lovingly grown without the use of commercial pesticides and fertilizers. Most folks would call it “organic,” but as that term continues to get over-used, its meaning continues to get watered down such that it no longer really means anything. We choose not to be “certified” since all that does is require us to spend a lot of time filling out forms rather than producing good food. Our approach is designed to ensure that we have time to pick the food in your basket fresh shortly before you receive it.

Pastured Eggs

Our eggs are produced by hens who are regularly moved onto fresh pasture. Unlike the hens that lay the commercially produced white eggs that you commonly get from the store, our chickens see real sunlight and real grass every day. This helps them to maintain a healthier diet and helps them to produce a healthier egg for you. You really should do a side-by-side test for yourself: cook our eggs next to the eggs you get from the store, and you will see and taste the difference that being on fresh grass makes to the chicken.

What are you doing?

We are striving to restore a symbiotic relationship to “heal our land” and restore the natural balance that the Creator intended. We do not use synthetic pesticides or fertilizers, but try to let the natural processes support each other as the cows, chickens, and the garden each contribute their part toward the proper balance of nature.
